



Patchwork & Quilting: New Classes – September 2011

Discover the unique pleasure of cutting up fabric and sewing it back together again in lots of creative ways!

Beginner level

This is a course of ten sessions designed to teach you some of the many Patchwork & Quilting techniques by both hand and machine. The classes will be held approximately once a month on Saturdays. Each class will focus on a specific technique so you can combine all your samples to make a sampler quilt. The first term will focus on traditional hand-piecing techniques followed by machine work & contemporary styles of patchwork.

Course fee: £300 (*Note:* This includes a small materials charge to cover handouts & other resources).

Intermediate level

A series of leisure classes for those who want to extend their skills and learn how to design & develop ideas for individual project work. A wide variety of traditional & contemporary methods will be covered with a flexible programme decided by the group at the beginning of each term. Intermediate level - City & Guilds 7716.62 Level 3 Certificate

The City & Guilds course is an exciting programme which encourages creative personal development. The Craft Unit covers numerous patchwork and quilting techniques including historical and regional styles.

The Design Unit covers the design skills which underpin all original creative design. It is not anticipated that students will have any prior knowledge of design or the various patchwork techniques, but sewing experience is definitely an advantage! Students can work towards the certificate for an additional fee to cover assessment (this is optional). See www.lynnequinn.com for examples of students' work & further course information. A series of leisure classes for experienced stitchers who want to develop their design skills and explore innovative and contemporary styles of quilting. The flexible programme will include techniques students wish to learn and will be decided as a group at the beginning of each term.
