



City & Guilds Design & Craft Courses in Patchwork & Quilting 2019-22

A chance to broaden your horizons! Study numerous different patchwork & quilting techniques, explore the design principles that develop confidence and learn how to design creatively. We have a lot of fun!

The 7716.62 Level 3 course (previously known as Part 1)

This course is suitable for those with sewing experience who want to learn a variety of patchwork & quilting techniques. *Places are limited so early booking is advised.* The course includes:

A Craft unit - which covers over 40 traditional & contemporary techniques

A Design unit - which covers the creative principles which govern all good design.

Five assessment projects which students choose from techniques they've enjoyed.

Five portfolios of design work based on Colour, Line, Shape, Texture & Form.

Please note: It is not anticipated that students will have previous experience of either the craft or design side of the course, so be assured that all skills are comprehensively taught to build up knowledge and experience. Both courses are supported with numerous handouts, an extensive library of books and a central stock of items to borrow.

Assessment is flexible for the adult learner there are no exams. Work is accredited by City & Guilds through the Link 2 Create centre for which there is an additional registration fee (£70.00).

The 7716.68 City & Guilds Diploma (previously known as Part II).

This an advanced level course for experienced stitchers with the emphasis on developing personal creativity and style! The course includes:

3 Research projects – the first is a visual study on a theme chosen by students. The second, a study of 4 contemporary quilters and the third, a look at the historical background to quilting.

A portfolio of original samples – covering a wide range of experimental techniques & materials

3 Assessment projects – A miniature quilt, a three-dimensional item and a final quilt for the wall or bed.

Assessment is flexible for the adult learner there are no exams. Work is accredited by City & Guilds through the Link 2 Create centre for which there is an additional registration fee (£70.00).
