



Leisure Class Information **2018-2019**

The following classes are held at the Linnaeus Study Room in the grounds of The University of Bristol Botanic Garden in Stoke Bishop. If you are interested in joining, I recommend you visit a class; you can meet me and the students, and talk to them about their work. Contact me through the link on the website for more information on specific classes and to arrange a visit.

Beginner level

The beginners class introduces new students to some of the many patchwork & quilting techniques in a friendly and informal class. The programme is structured to develop skills and confidence and covers hand-sewing techniques in the first (Autumn) term, machine techniques in the Spring Term followed by finishing techniques in the Summer term. You will make a series of samples that can be put together as a sampler quilt in a colour scheme of your choice. (There are lots of examples to see on the website).

Please note: last years 'beginners' are continuing which means I won't be able to take new students till September 2019, but please contact me if you'd like to be put down for the class.

Day/Time: Friday pm1.00-4.00 (fortnightly) Term dates & costs to be arranged.

Intermediate level *There are three classes suitable for intermediate students:*

Day/Time: Tuesday pm 1.00 - 4.00. Friday am - 9.30 - 12.30 & Friday pm1.00 - 4.00

These classes are an opportunity for students to build on existing skills and develop ideas for individual project work. A wide variety of traditional & contemporary methods will be covered with a flexible programme decided by the group at the beginning of each term.

Advanced level *There are two classes suitable for advanced students:*

Day/Time: Tuesday 9.30 - 12.30 & Friday am - 9.30 - 12.30

These classes are for experienced stitchers who want to develop their design skills and explore innovative, contemporary styles of quilting. The flexible programme includes techniques requested by students and is planned at the beginning of each term.
