Design and Craft - Leisure Course

This course will run along similar principles to the previous City & Guilds Level 3 course (known as Part 1). You'll study numerous different patchwork & quilting techniques, explore the design principles that generate ideas and spark your imagination, and learn how to translate your ideas into original stitched pieces. You'll make samples, keep a sketchbook and complete the course with an original stitched piece you've designed yourself. For fuller details please see the Courses link at the top of the Homepage.

The course is suitable for those with sewing experience who want to learn a variety of patchwork & quilting techniques. It is not anticipated that students will have previous experience of either the patchwork or design side of the course, so be assured that all skills are comprehensively taught to build up knowledge and experience. Courses are supported with numerous handouts, an extensive library of books and a central stock of items to borrow. (Note: Stock fee for some materials used, included in course fee).

- Year A will cover Applique techniques & related design work
- Year B will cover Block patchwork techniques & related design work
- Year C will cover Contemporary & Traditional techniques & related design work

Plus each year will include quilting, finishing techniques and a range of textile decoration techniques.

It is a leisure class designed to provide space for people to develop their own ideas with both tutor support and a group of like-minded people to bounce ideas off! I'll have a pin-wall in the new studio, table space to layer-up and the facilities to do dyeing and printing! As with all the leisure classes (except for the Beginners) there is no set schedule, people can decide if they want to work individually or on a group project and we can draw up a programme based on techniques requested.
